WHAT DOES CAROLINA PREMIER BANK DO WITH YOUR INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- **Social Security Number**
- **Account balances**
- **Account transactions**
- **Credit history**
- **Payment history**
- **Transaction history**

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share their **customer's** personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their **customer's** personal information, the reasons **Carolina Premier Bank** chooses to share, and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Carolina Premier Bank protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect this information

Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes- information about your creditworthiness • Affiliates from using your information to market to you • Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial or nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>We may disclose information about you in the future to the following types of affiliates: our affiliates include financial companies, such as insurance agents.</i>
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Carolina Premier Bank does not share with non-affiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Our joint marketing partners include: credit card companies.</i>
